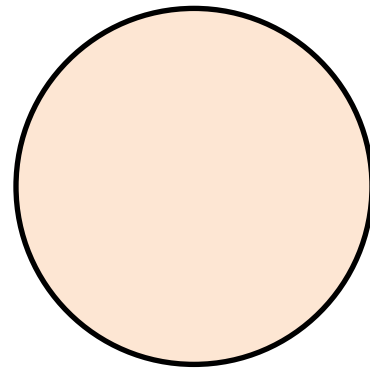
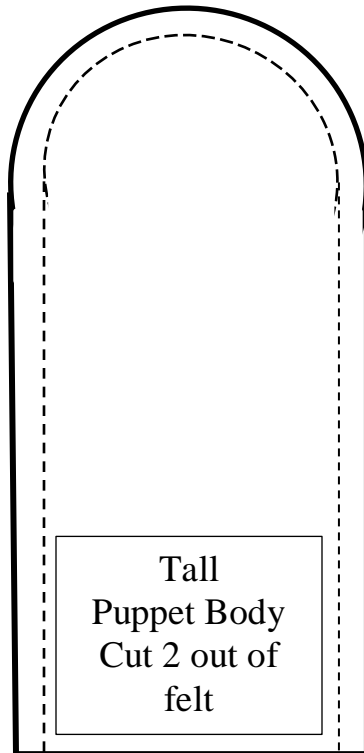
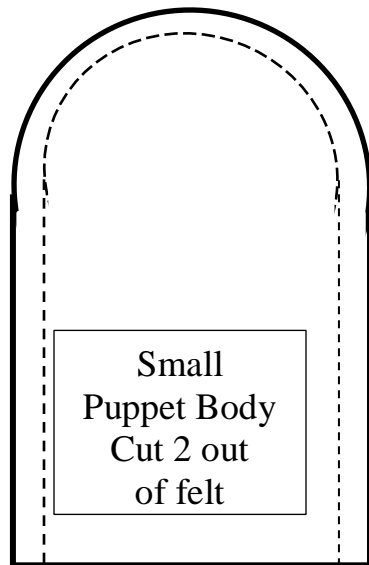


Finger Puppet Patterns – by Brenda Still



Face – cut 1 out of felt

Instructions:

1. Cut out pattern pieces
2. Sew along dotted line
3. Glue on extras like hair and eyes. Use a glue gun or tacky glue
4. Draw on faces with fabric paint or permanent marker.

NOTE: Ears and hands can be cut and put in place before sewing – then just sew through everything.
